Re: Ysgol Eirias GCSE Results Day 2024

As you begin your exam period, I hope you can reflect upon the last year and feel proud of your achievements.

Your exam results will be available to you on Thursday 22nd August. Please see below for a set of frequently asked questions. If you have any further questions, please get in touch with Mrs. Rogers (RogersK54@Hwbcmru.net).

When and where do I collect my results?

Your GCSE results will be available for collection from school on **Thursday 22nd August 2024 from 9a.m.** Please arrive at school and go to the school library for 9a.m. where you will be met by Mrs Rogers and the team who are distributing your results.

Results will also be emailed to all learners via Talaxy at approximately 2pm.

How do I sign up for Sixth Form?

When you receive your results, you will be given a sheet to complete with details of the entry requirements for the Sixth Form courses that you are interested in. When you have filled this sheet in, take it along to the Sixth Form Team, who will be based in the Reading Room. There the Sixth Form Team can sign you up for the courses you have chosen.

What happens if I don't get the results I need for my next steps?

Please do not panic. Mrs. Rogers and the team will be available during the morning to support you and to guide you through the options available to you for your next steps. If you are concerned about not meeting the requirements for your Sixth Form subject options, the Sixth Form Team will discuss this with you and will help you to resolve any issues.

What if I can't collect my results in person?

Results will be emailed to all learners via Talaxy at approximately 2pm.

If you are unable to collect your results in person, you can give authorisation for your parent/carer to collect your results at 9am. Please write a letter requesting this and ask your parent/carer to bring this letter plus proof of their identity with them, e.g. passport or driving licence.

When do I get my GCSE certificates?

GCSE certificates arrive in school mid-November. If you stay with us for Sixth Form, you will receive your certificates via your form tutor in December. If you have left school but still have a sibling in school, your certificates will be given to them for them to bring home and give to you. If you have left school and do not have a sibling in school, then please ring the school in December and arrange to collect your certificates.
