Attendance Update

Our '12 Days of Christmas' attendance initiative continues to have a positive impact across the school. Whole-school attendance during the 12-day period this year reached 88.8%, a slight improvement on last year and a sign of continued progress. Even more encouragingly, this is over 5% higher than our figure two years ago!



Across the 12 days, many learners were rewarded with prizes, including daily treats and gift cards, with two special grand prize hampers awarded at the end of the initiative. It was fantastic to see so many pupils recognised and celebrating excellent attendance. This steady upward trend reflects the commitment of our pupils and families in supporting regular attendance — **thank you for helping us make every school day count.**
