


Dear Parents & Guardians,

Our '12 Days of Christmas' Attendance Campaign has been a success and, in comparison to December 2023, this year we saw that:

- Whole school attendance was higher every day in the 12 days leading up to the Xmas break
- Whole school attendance was 4.5% higher overall for the 12 days of Xmas
- Whole school attendance on the final day of the Xmas term was 10.5% higher

 supporting our young people to get the most out of their education.


