



Introduction

After more than ten years of school, homework, studying and exams, for some people it's time to take a break before they go to college or university. For some, taking a year off can turn out to be the experience of a lifetime.

The important thing is to weigh up the pros and cons of taking a year out, make some firm decisions about what you intend to do, and then plan carefully to make sure that everything goes well.

Good things that could come from your gap year



Gap Year

What you could do:

- Travel.
- Teach abroad.
- Volunteer to work on a project at home or abroad.
- Work in a paid position to save some money for university.
- Gain some unpaid work experience.
- Undertake further study or training.

The Pros and Cons of a Gap Year

Pros:

- You may feel more motivated when you return to learning.
- You may have the chance to work or study in an area related to your course.
- You may have the opportunity to travel, see new places and have new experiences.
- If you decide on paid work you can earn some money to help finance your degree.
- You could gain a sense of real personal achievement through your gap year activities.
- A year of more independent living can mean that you are more mature when you begin university.
- If you decide to work or volunteer you can gain new skills and develop existing ones.

Cons:


- You may find it hard to settle back into your studies.
- You may not be able to discipline yourself for independent study when you return.
- It could be expensive, for example if you decide to travel or do unpaid work experience.
- Your friends may go off to university while you will be a year behind them.
- If you don't spend it productively this could give employers a bad impression.



Things to Consider

- If you want to take a gap year, you'll need to decide what you want to do and then plan it carefully.
- Make sure you understand your reasons for a gap year.
- Research the options so you make the right decisions.
- Gap year organisations can be helpful, but you don't have to use one.
- Set yourself goals, so you know what you want to accomplish in your year out.
- Plan your finances, so you don't get into debt. Think about how much you need to earn and/or how much you will spend.

An Apprenticeship is a job that includes working towards a nationally recognised qualification. There are three levels of Apprenticeships: Foundation Apprenticeship, Apprenticeship and Higher Apprenticeship, because different jobs need different levels of qualifications.

Being an apprentice gives you the opportunity to gain a recognised qualification and develop professional skills, whilst earning a salary.




