**Dear Parents and Carers** 

Finally, the end of the summer assessment process is now in sight. I am delighted to inform you that our learners have worked incredibly hard on these assessments, I have been very proud of their resilience, attendance and commitment after such a challenging time.

Some updates for you:

Progress data 'health checks'

I hope that you and your child found the data 'health check' that we released on the 12<sup>th</sup> May helpful. These grades provided the latest thinking on your child's Centre Determined Grades (CDGs) based on assessments that had been carried out to date.

**Final Grading** 

Teachers will now be finalising their grading decisions. Teachers will use the information provided by the assessments in addition to the wider knowledge of their learners to determine the grade. They will evaluate the quality of the evidence, consider any extenuating circumstances and assign a grade. Grades will be awarded holistically using a best fit judgement against the WJEC grade descriptors. Teachers will document their grading decisions and assessment evidence base in a Learner Decision Making Record (LDMR). As you will be aware, teachers have informed learners of the assessment evidence that will be used to determine their grade in each subject.

Centre Reviews and WJEC Appeals

Schools and colleges across Wales have applied internal quality assurance arrangements and WJEC has undertaken external quality assurance arrangements for 2021. However, errors may occasionally occur. If your child believes that an error has been made in the determination of their grade they may ask the school to provide a copy of the Learner Decision Making Record (LDMR) for subjects where they believe an error may have been made.

The LDMR provides the teacher's rationale for the grade awarded. If after reading the rationale and the contents of the LDMR, your child still genuinely believes an error has been made that has had a material effect on the accuracy of their CDG, they are able to request that the school review the grade.

All Centre Review requests must use the WJEC Centre Review and Appeals request form that will be made available on the website when grades are released.

Please note that learners are not able to negotiate which evidence is included in the range of evidence used to determine their grades.

Learners that ask for a grade to be reviewed must provide written permission because **the grade may go down** as a result of the review.

Should the Centre Review process result in the school upholding its original decision, learners may choose to appeal to the WJEC (Stage 2 appeal).

**Timeline** 

In Ysgol Eirias, grades will be released to learners, via Talaxy, on 15th June.




















We are required to submit Centre Determined Grades to WJEC by 2<sup>nd</sup> July. If your child has requested a Review which results in a grade change, we must inform WJEC of the grade change by 20<sup>th</sup> July to ensure that the grade can be amended prior to results day.
