

EXPECTATIONS



School uniform is compulsory for all learners. The final decision in any matter relating to uniform lies with the Headteacher. Please note: The school will not be responsible for valuable items brought into school.

1 Provides a sense of identity and cohesion.



Any expectations on what to wear are removed, developing a greater sense of equality between children and reducing bullying. The uniform reinforces our inclusive approach, that despite individual differences, we are all part of the Ysgol Eirias family.

2 Improves wellbeing and study ethic.



The worry of what to wear to school can be damaging to self-confidence and a distraction to learning. A lack of confidence can be one of the most significant barriers to wellbeing and academic growth.

3 Places a focus on character



Children should be prioritising the development of their personality, having the confidence to be who they are and not be defined by material things like the clothes they wear, or the colour of their hair or the jewellery they wear. With a school uniform, your child can express themselves in more meaningful ways, which helps to develop their creativity.

4 Increases safety.



With their school uniform on, children can immediately be recognised at a distance as a member of Ysgol Eirias. Strangers can be easily identified as not part of the school by their lack of uniform.

5 Preparation for the outside world.




School uniform prepares children for the formal scenarios that they encounter in their life, for example job interviews.

6 Easier economics for parents




With school uniforms, economics is made easier for parents. You know exactly what to buy and when to buy it, and often uniform can be used for more than one school year.

MUST WEAR

- Plain white school shirt worn with a school tie in house colours.
- Maroon jumper with school badge (KS3/4). Black jumper with logo (KS5). To be worn when moving around school.



DON'T WEAR

- Hoodies, jumpers or tops that are not part of the Ysgol Eirias uniform.





MUST WEAR

- Black full length plain trousers OR a plain black skirt of appropriate length.
- Plain black tights must be worn with skirts (as a guide tights should be 80 Denier or over).



DON'T WEAR


- Jeans, jeans style, skin-tight or leggings style bottoms.
- Socks (of any length) are not permitted to be worn with skirts.

MUST WEAR

- Plain, flat, black leather type footwear.
- Footwear must be ankle height or lower.



DON'T WEAR

- Any footwear that is not flat, black leather type including:
- Canvas style footwear.
- Footwear that is above the ankle (no boots).
- Heels.



- Hair should be neat and tidy and an even natural colour.
- Religious headwear, if worn, should be plain black.
- For health and safety purposes jewellery worn should be kept to a minimum.
- Make up, if worn, should be natural looking.
- A strong school bag to carry equipment including pens, pencils, ruler, calculator etc.



- No extreme hairstyles are permitted e.g., very short or tramlines.
- No personal use of mobile phones.
- No use of headphones or airpods.
