As we near the end of term, it's a great time to celebrate the effort and progress of our young people. They continue to show the Eirias values in action and we are proud of the way they embody these each day.

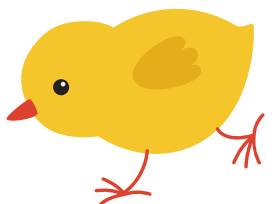

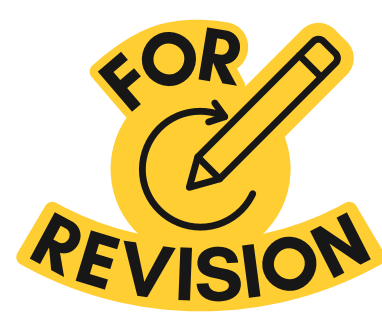
